The Providence school lunch programs shall be designed to encourage good nutrition within an environment which will enhance the educational experiences of the pupils The Superintendent shall be responsible to insure that this policy is achieved in accordance with state regulations, and within available fiscal resources.

Programs offering free or reduced priced meals should be made available to selected pupils within available funding, and in coordination with, but not limited to, federal and state sponsored school lunch programs.

The educational aspects of the school lunch program shall be the responsibility of each school principal, subject to the advice and counsel of the Superintendent.
